





Enabling University Peace Education Project Call for Applications Training for Students



Bahir Dar University, in collaboration with the British Council and the European Union, has been running a project since 2022 entitled "Enabling University Peace Education" (EUPE).

The EUPE project aims to support a generation of young university students, particularly women, to participate more effectively in peacebuilding. The project's objective is to enable universities in Ethiopia to provide contextual and relevant peace education for their students and strengthen the peace research activities of the universities in collaboration with local, regional, and international partners.

In line with this, Bahir Dar University, in collaboration with the British Council and the European Union, plans to engage a total of 454 undergraduate students from all campuses. Therefore, a call for applications is now open. To be eligible, applicants must submit hard copies of their documents from February 26, 2024, to March 1, 2024, to the respective Students Union Office.

Selection Criteria

To qualify for selection, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- ♠ Must be undergraduate students, with good academic standing.
- Students from any subject discipline are eligible.
- ♠ Must be motivated to learn about peace.

- Should be active participants, enthusiastic about working with other students, sharing opinions, listening to others, and open to learning through participatory activities.
- Must be committed to completing the full course and all the sessions/modules.
- ♠ Must have sufficient time to attend all the peace education modules.
- Must be willing to provide information for EUPE's monitoring, evaluation, and learning (MEL), such as student questionnaires before and after the course/module (following data protection regulations set by the British Council).
- Applicants are required to submit latest grade report.

Please Note that:

- Graduating class students are not eligible for selection.
- Priority will be given to female and disabled applicants.
