The College of Education and Behavioral Sciences at Bahir Dar University is celebrating its 50th anniversary in 2022/2023. Over the past fifty years, the college has contributed immensely to the country's need for manpower in education – teachers, leaders, experts, researchers etc. Ten years after its founding, the College began the May Annual Educational Conference, which was renamed as the International May Annual International Educational Conference in 2014. This year's conference is the 40th conference and coincides with the College's 50th anniversary. As recent reports show, only 3.3% of high school graduates managed to score passing marks in the 12th grade national exam.
